The company now exports to the United Kingdom, the US and New Zealand, and is exploring opportunities in India, as well as designing and making equipment for the pie making industry in Australia and overseas.

Lindsay PieMaking Equipment won the Highly Commended award in the Regional Excellence Award for an Outstanding Product (SME) category at the 2006 Western Sydney Industry Awards. The company was highly
